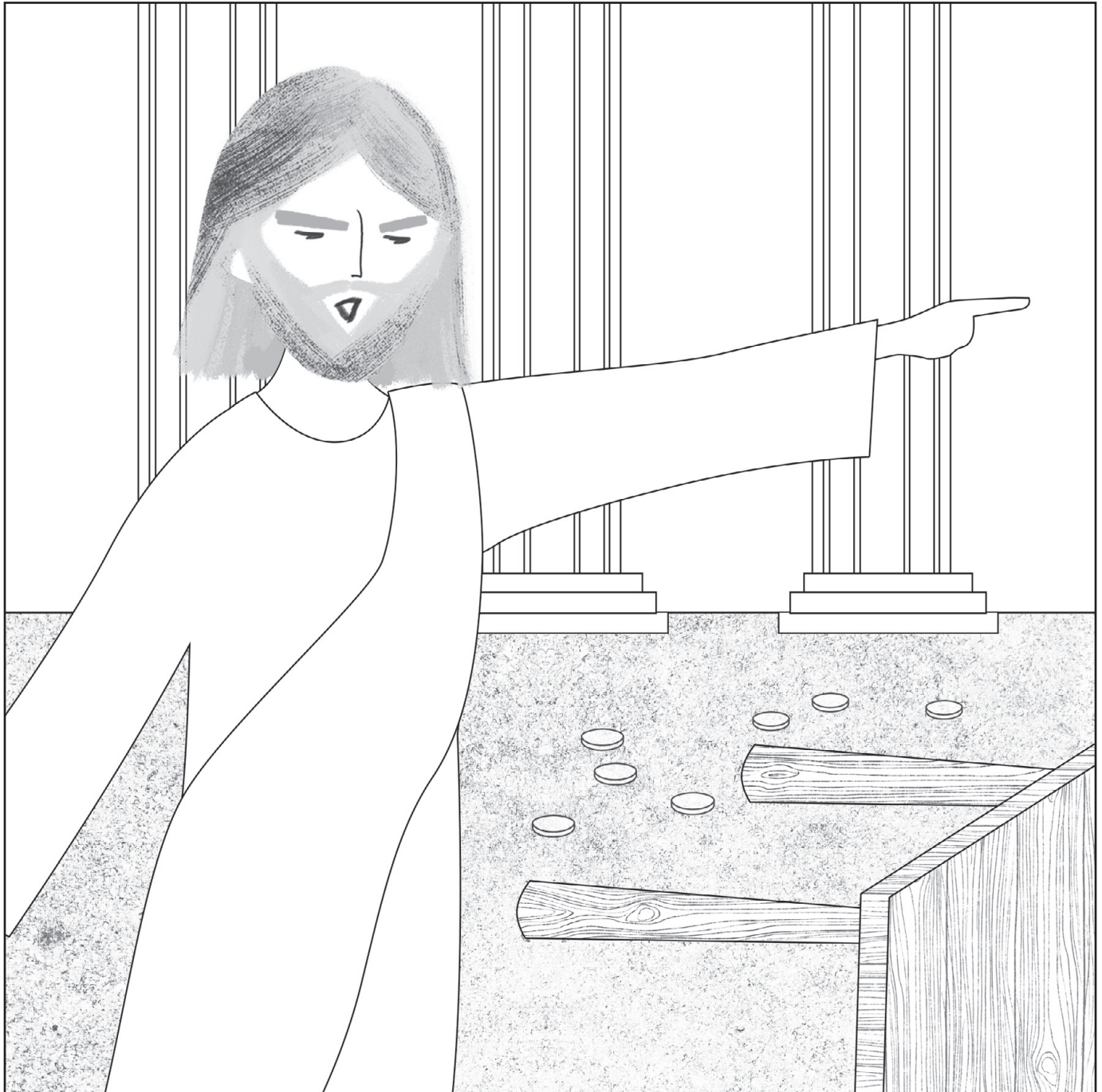

When the temple was clean, Jesus stayed there healing and teaching.

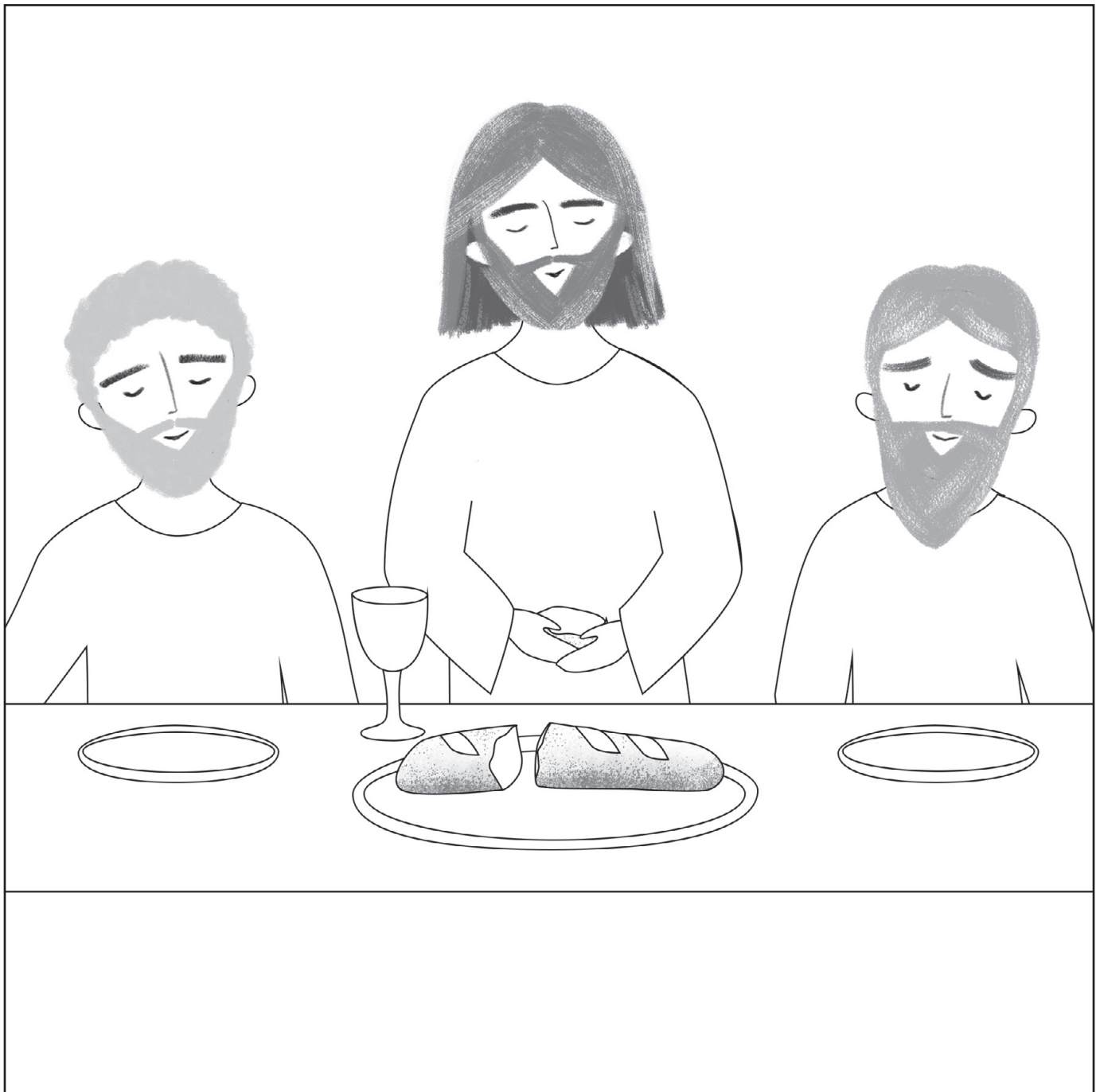
LOVED

FRUSTRATED

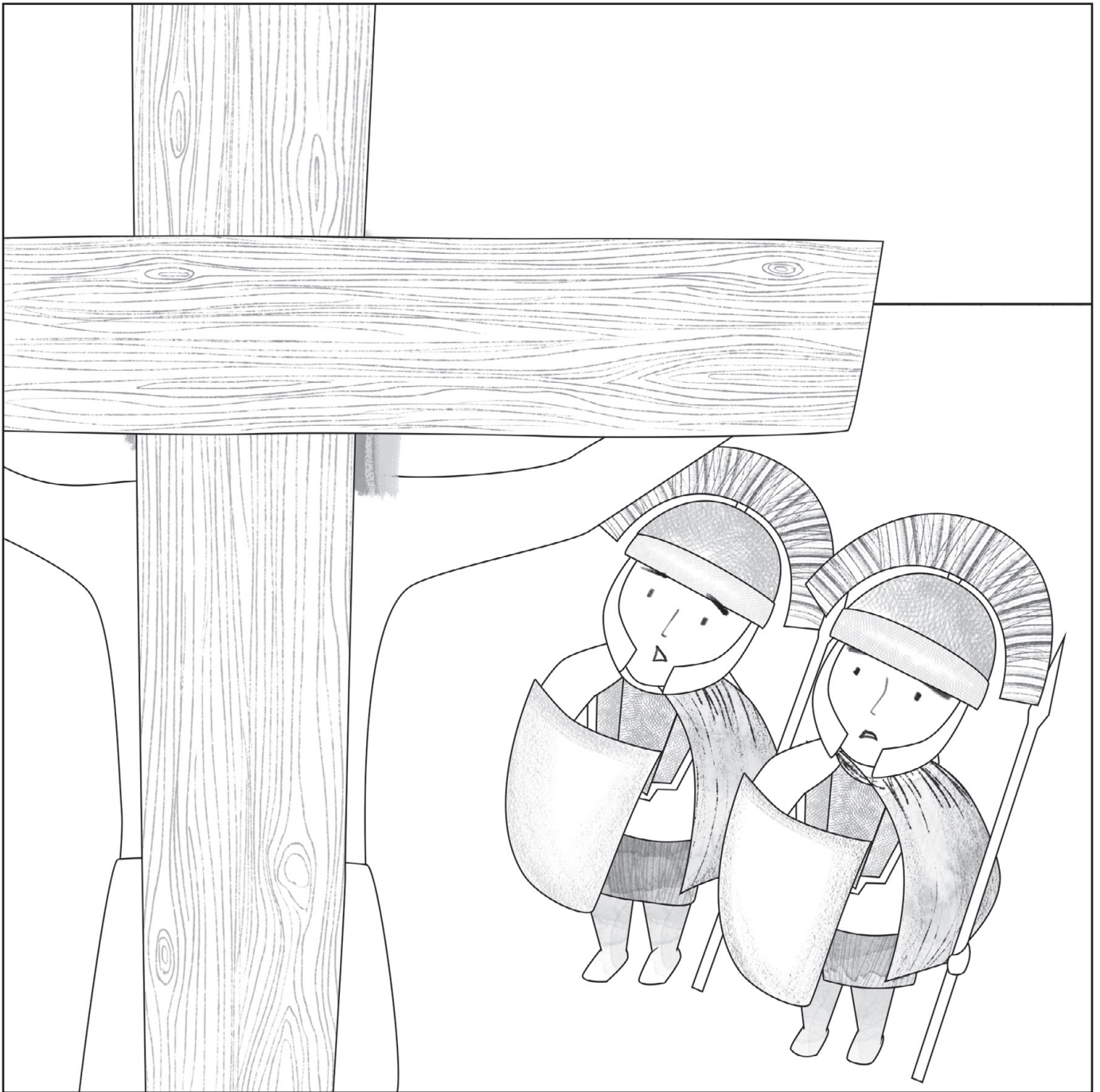

SCARED

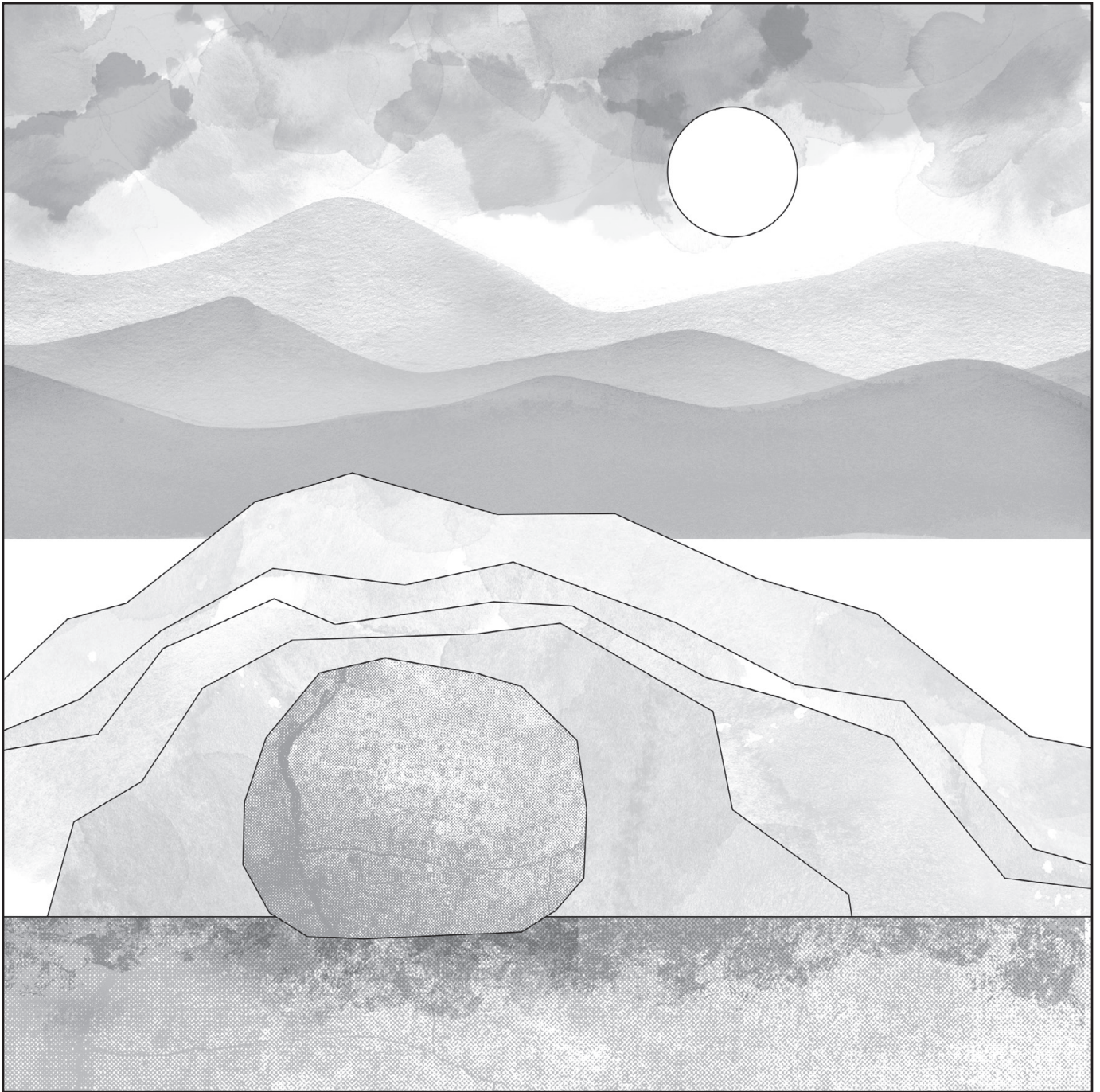

SURPRISED

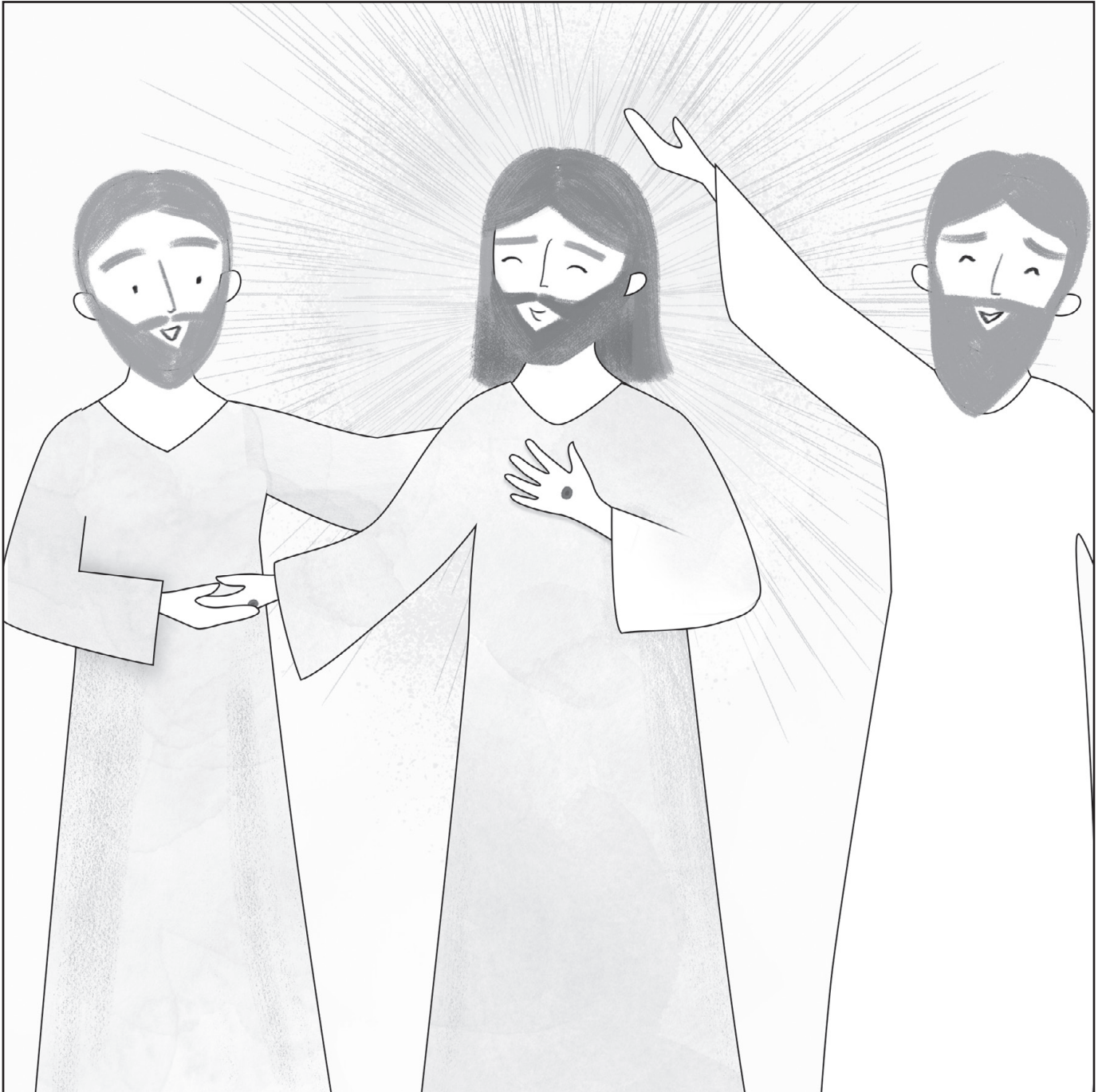
