

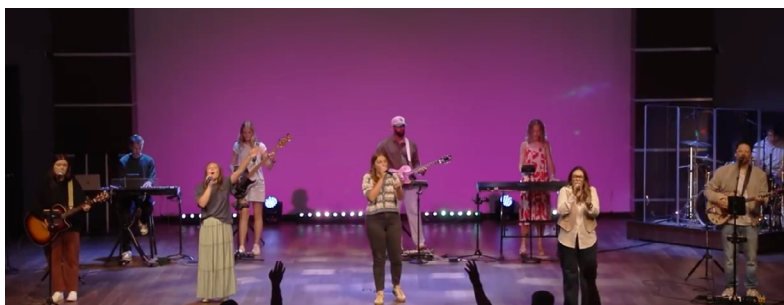

On June 7, we had our annual celebration connect service in Sioux Center. During this service we took time to look back on how God has been working in and through Centerpoint Church over the past year.

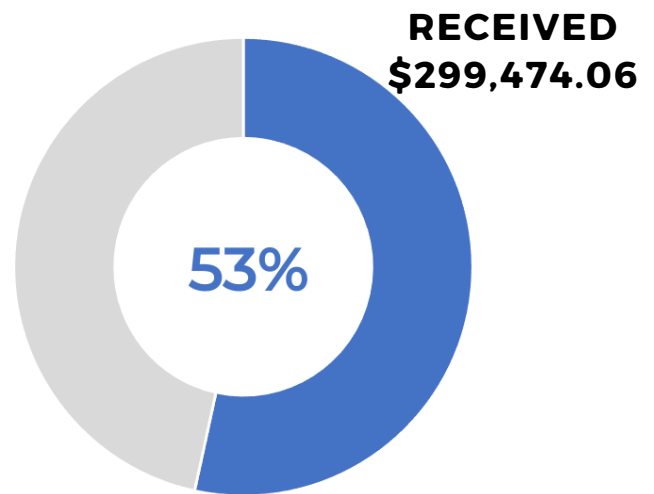
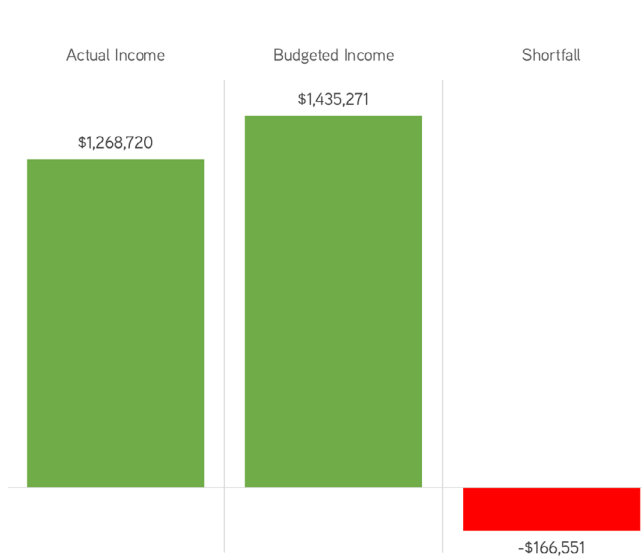
We worshipped together, heard a message from 1 Kings 18, and had an opportunity to re-install Brad Den Herder and Mark Sneller as elders for their second terms.
