

BOARD UPDATE

On August 18, the board met for its regularly scheduled meeting. We opened with a devotion and split into groups for prayer. We continue to review the principles of Policy Governance, and this month we reviewed Principle 1: Represent Christ Above All! Click here to watch the video.

Each month the board reviews one of the five ends that we have as a church which include: Worship, Discipleship, Missional Engagement, Multiplication, and Healthy Culture. This month we reviewed the end of Healthy Culture which reads: Centerpoint Church will invest our personal comfort, vulnerability, courage, time, and authenticity in order to grow in spiritual maturity and the Fruits of the Spirit. As a result, the spiritual culture within our communities will become more healthy. Time was spent discussing the culture of our staff as well as our congregation. Overall, it was a positive assessment of both the staff and the congregation.

As a reminder, our church uses Policy Governance as our method of governance. The board is made up of the lead pastor (Jamie Dykstra), and six elders elected from our covenant partners (Brad Den Herder, Eric Heitbrink, Mark Sneller, TJ Speer, Jack Woelber, and Jill Zwart). Annually, we elect board members to certain offices. This year, Mark Sneller was elected Vice President, TJ Speer as Treasurer, and Jack Woelber as Chief Governance Officer. The lead pastor serves as the President of the board.

We spent some time this month discussing the process the board uses in hearing and discerning the voice of the Spirit through the congregation and Covenant Partners in order to get insight from the broader Church to set the long-term vision and direction of Centerpoint. In the past, one of the ways we did this was to hold Covenant Partner meetings using our values as a focus to structure the conversation. During this meeting we thought about other creative ways we can use to that end. No formal decision was made, but we are pursuing some other options.
