### **#WEGETTODOTHIS**

**Commanders:** The commanders "lead the troops" throughout the night. They handle announcements at opening and closing ceremonies. They provide support to the large group teachers and handbook leaders and make sure everyone stays on schedule and that we rotate at the appropriate times. The commanders also handle discipline issues.

**Secretaries:** The secretaries maintain records on clubber's attendance and achievement and provide support to the handbook leaders. They distribute emblems and/or jewels to children as they are earned. They also coordinate the Awana Store, keep track of Awana inventory, and prepare certificates and awards for Awards Night.

**Large Group Leader:** The large group teachers prepare and deliver age-appropriate biblical lessons to their entire club during Large Group Time. These lessons impact the children's spiritual lives as they hear God's Word and the gospel message.

**Handbook Leader:** A handbook leader is paired with a group of 3-5 children and is encouraged to participate in each of the three main segments with this group. One of the main responsibilities of the handbook leader is to love and lead this group through their AWANA handbook during the handbook time segment. This is a great time to build relationships with and teach spiritual truths to the younger generation.

**Game Leader:** The Game Leaders plan exciting team games and encourage an atmosphere of healthy competition, good sportsmanship, and teamwork. They exhibit enthusiasm and a positive 'let's have fun" attitude!

Sewers: The Sewers use their gifts of sewing to attach badges to Awana shirts twice a month during the Awana year.



**Check in/Check Out:** You love interacting with kids and are comfortable using computer software to check in and check out large groups of kids.



Name Tags: You are friendly and helpful as you assist kids in finding and putting on their name tags at check in.

**Coat Room:** You are comfortable giving direction and helping kids stay organized as they hang up their coats and backpacks.
