RESTORATION OF OUR HEARTS

January 4-10: Pray for restored wonder at God's holiness and glory.

January 11-17: Pray for God to renew in us a deep love for Christ above all earthly things.

January 18-24: Pray for restoration from spiritual dryness and apathy.

January 25-31: Pray for God to soften hardened hearts and make us responsive to His Word.

February 1-7: Pray for renewed joy in salvation.

February 8-14: Pray for restored confidence in God's faithfulness when we feel weary.

February 15-21: Pray for restoration of gratitude in all circumstances.

February 22-28: Pray for God to restore in us a spirit of repentance and humility.



RESTORATION THROUGH THE GOSPEL

March 1-7: Pray that the gospel would restore hope in those who feel broken.

March 8-14: Pray that the Spirit would restore assurance for those doubting their salvation.

March 15-21: Pray for a renewed focus on Christ's finished work rather than self-reliance.

March 22-28: Pray for restoration of true worship that centers on God's Word.

March 29-April 4: Pray for God to restore our understanding of grace—unearned, undeserved, freely given.

April 5-11: Pray that the gospel would restore relationships burdened by sin or misunderstanding.



RESTORATION OF THE CHURCH COMMUNITY

April 12-18: Pray for God to restore unity where division has taken root.

April 19-25: Pray for restoration of biblical fellowship marked by mutual encouragement.

April 26-May 2: Pray for God to restore a spirit of service and volunteerism in the church body.

May 3-9: Pray for restored trust among leaders and members.

May 10-16: Pray for God to restore healthy accountability among believers.

May 17-23: Pray for God to restore a culture of generational discipleship—older believers investing in younger ones.

May 24-30: Pray for the restoration of joy in gathering together weekly.

May 31-June 6: Pray for God to restore marriages strained by conflict.

June 7-13: Pray for restoration between parents and children.

June 14-20: Pray for God to restore families who have drifted from church involvement.

June 21-27: Pray for God to restore hope to single parents and strengthen them with wisdom and grace.

June 28-July 4: Pray for restoration for children and teens who have wandered from the faith.

July 5-11: Pray for God to restore spiritual leadership in homes through Christ-centered practices.

July 12-18: Pray for God to restore boldness in evangelism.

July 19-25: Pray for restoration of compassion for the lost.

July 26-August 1: Pray that God would restore credibility in our community through integrity and love.

August 2-8: Pray for restored passion for global missions.

August 9-15: Pray for God to restore a heart for justice and mercy that reflects Christ's character.

August 16-22: Pray for restored obedience in following God's call, wherever He leads.

August 23-29: Pray for God to restore peace in neighborhoods affected by violence.

August 30-September 5: Pray for the restoration of hope for those experiencing homelessness and poverty.

September 13-19: Pray for God to restore relationships across racial, cultural, and generational divides.

September 20-26: Pray for the restoration of godly wisdom in civic leaders.

September 27-October 3: Pray for God to restore spiritual hunger throughout the city.

October 4-10: Pray for God to restore our understanding of work as worship.

October 11-17: Pray for restoration from burnout among workers, teachers, healthcare professionals, and caregivers.

October 18-24: Pray for God to restore creativity, skill, and diligence in our vocations.

October 25-31: Pray for restoration of stewardship—of time, resources, and creation itself.

November 1-7: Pray for God to restore ethical integrity in workplaces and businesses.



RESTORATION OF THE BROKENHEARTED

November 8-14: Pray for God to restore those grieving the loss of loved ones.

November 15-21: Pray for restoration for those struggling with chronic illness or pain.

November 22-28: Pray for God to restore those battling addiction or destructive habits.

November 29-December 5: Pray for restoration for those suffering from loneliness, rejection, or shame.

December 6-12: Pray for God to restore courage for those facing fear or uncertainty.

December 13-19: Pray for the restoration of peace for those experiencing anxiety or depression.

December 20-26: Pray for restored anticipation of Christ's return and the renewal of all things.
